BASIX® is designed to reduce water and energy consumption in homes across NSW. The Building Sustainability Index (BASIX®) aims to deliver equitable, effective water and greenhouse gas reductions across the state. It is mandatory, applies to all residential dwelling types and is part of the development application process in NSW.

These environmental outcomes provide a long term financial saving for the homeowner, along with a valuable contribution to the sustainable future of our communities- it's good for all of us.

So, how is BASIX® measured?

BASIX® is broken into three main categories that you need to look at to achieve your BASIX® certificate:



Energy

(Increased BASIX® energy target)



Water

(These targets remain the same as previous requirements)



Thermal Comfort

(Increases to the thermal comfort requirements)

What is the role of Glass in BASIX® compliance?

Glass plays an incredibly important role in the new BASIX® targets. Particularly in the Energy and Thermal Comfort sections of compliance. Ordinary glass, used in even the best window frame, will always result in poor insulation. Achieving the right amount of natural light without compromising your design and the amount of energy (heating and cooling) lost through its surface is only achievable by using energy efficiency glass.

Use of quality glass will

- Reduce energy usage by insulating and maintaining temperature inside the home.
 This has huge impacts on the levels of cooling and heating needed to bring the house to comfortable levels, increasing both your Energy and Thermal Comfort rating to help you meet BASIX® requirement.
- Reduce energy usage through a greater availability of natural light leading to less of a reliance on artificial and powered light.

SmartGlass™ can improve glass insulation by up to 39% compared to ordinary glass.

Double glazing with Low E

For exceptional performance and quality and versatility you should use LightBridgeTM. LightBridgeTM is our highest performing double glazed unit and it provides exceptional climate, energy and acoustic control as well as allowing you more glazing and natural light than ordinary glass. All this without compromising comfort.
